A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to public school curriculum and textbook restrictions based on science,**
2 **resource development, and sustained yield principles."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 14.30.380 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the governing body of each
6 public school in the state shall base curriculum development and textbook selection on

7 (1) the constitutional principles of

8 (A) utilization, maintenance, and sustained yield of all natural
9 resources belonging to the state, including fish, forests, wildlife, land, water,
10 and other renewable resources; and

11 (B) utilization and development of all nonrenewable resources
12 in addition to encouragement of balancing resource development and
13 conservation under (a) of this section;

14 (2) scientific principles, without bias and without regard to personal
