1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**
2 **Legislature, concerning Senate Bill No. 74, requiring insurance coverage for autism**
3 **spectrum disorders, describing the method for establishing a covered treatment plan for**
4 **those disorders, and defining the covered treatment for those disorders.**

5 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
7 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding
8 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of Senate Bill No. 74, requiring
9 insurance coverage for autism spectrum disorders, describing the method for establishing a
10 covered treatment plan for those disorders, and defining the covered treatment for those
11 disorders.
