A RESOLUTION

1 **Suspending Rules 47 and 55, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, and other**
2 **rules of parliamentary procedure, relating to the carryover of bills.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 That under Rule 54 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the
5 provisions of Rule 47 of the Uniform Rules regarding the carryover of bills, the provisions of
6 Rule 55 of the Uniform Rules regarding the use of Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure
7 to cover situations not directly addressed by the Uniform Rules, and all other principles of
8 parliamentary procedure from whatever authority that would prevent the carryover of House
9 Bill No. 106, including principles in support of finality, are suspended to the extent they
10 prohibit the carryover of a bill from a special session of the Twenty-Seventh Alaska State
11 Legislature to another special session of the Twenty-Seventh Alaska State Legislature; and be
12 it

13 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution applies only to House Bill No. 106,
14 extending the termination date of the Alaska coastal management program and relating to the
15 extension; relating to the review of activities and regulations of the Alaska coastal
16 management program; establishing the Alaska Coastal Policy Board; relating to the

1 development, review, and approval of district coastal management plans; relating to the duties
2 of the Department of Natural Resources relating to the Alaska coastal management program;
3 relating to the review of certain consistency determinations; and providing for an effective
4 date by amending the effective date of secs. 1 - 13 and 18, ch. 31, SLA 2005, which was
5 introduced in the First Regular Session of the Twenty-Seventh Alaska State Legislature, was
6 considered as pending legislation during the First Special Session of the Alaska State
7 Legislature, and, under this resolution, remains subject to additional legislative action,
8 including referral to a free conference committee.
