A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to penalties for certain alcohol offenses involving persons under 21
2 years of age committed by certain sex offenders or child kidnappers."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 04.16 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 04.16.059. Aggravated penalties for violations of AS 04.16.051,**
6 **04.16.055, and 04.16.057 involving a person under 21 years of age and committed**
7 **by a sex offender or child kidnapper.** (a) Notwithstanding AS 04.16.051, 04.16.055,
8 04.16.057, and 04.16.180, the penalty for a violation of AS 04.16.051, 04.16.055, or
9 04.16.057 that involved a person under 21 years of age and that was committed by a
10 person who is required to register as a sex offender or child kidnapper under AS 12.63
11 is as follows:

12 (1) if the underlying offense is a violation, a sex offender or child
13 kidnapper committing the offense is guilty of a class B misdemeanor and shall be
14 punished as provided in AS 12.55;

1 (2) if the underlying offense is a class A misdemeanor, a sex offender
2 or child kidnapper committing the offense is guilty of a class C felony and shall be
3 punished as provided in AS 12.55;

4 (3) if the underlying offense is a class C felony, a sex offender or child
5 kidnapper committing the offense is guilty of a class B felony and shall be punished as
6 provided in AS 12.55.

7 (b) In this section, "sex offender or child kidnapper" has the meaning given in
8 AS 12.63.100.

9 * **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 **APPLICABILITY.** This Act applies to offenses committed on or after the effective
12 date of this Act.
