**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Suspending Rules 47 and 55, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, relating to**  
2 **the carry-over of bills to a special session.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of  
5 Rule 47 of the Uniform Rules regarding the carry-over of bills and the provisions of Rule 55  
6 of the Uniform Rules regarding the use of Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure, 2012  
7 edition, to cover situations not directly addressed by the Uniform Rules, are suspended to the  
8 extent they prohibit the carry-over of bills and resolutions from the Second Regular Session to  
9 the Third Special Session of the Twenty-Seventh Alaska State Legislature; and be it

10 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution applies only to the following bills that  
11 relate to the subjects set out in the governor's proclamation for the special session:

12 House Bill 9 -- in-state gasline development corporation, previously under  
13 consideration during the second regular session of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the  
14 State of Alaska;

15 House Bill 359 -- sex crimes; testimony by video conference, previously under  
16 consideration during the second regular session of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the

1 State of Alaska; and be it

2 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution is retroactive to April 18, 2012, at 1:00

3 p.m., the beginning of the Third Special Session of the Twenty-Seventh Alaska Legislature.
