**BILL NO. HB 179**

**Analysis**

HB 179 amends existing animal cruelty law to include failing to care for five or more animals and causing death, severe physical pain, or prolonged suffering to the animals.

Department of Corrections is unable to determine the fiscal impacts of the passage of this legislation, as we cannot estimate the total number of actual violations that will occur.

The Department of Corrections will closely monitor potential future fiscal impacts of this legislation.
