**BILL NO. CSSB 174(L&C)**

**Analysis**

This proposed legislation states that oil and gas producers with 100 or more employees in Alaska shall notify the Commissioner of available job opportunities in the state. The Commissioner shall cause the notification to be posted on the Alaska Online Public Notice System and distribute the notification to other entities.

Currently, all industries, including oil and gas, have access to post job opportunities on the public Alaska Labor Exchange System (ALEXsys), which the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development maintains.

There is no fiscal impact to the department as a result of this legislation.
