January 19, 2011

#### Second Day

Pursuant to adjournment the House was called to order by Speaker Chenault at 6:51 p.m.

The Speaker stated that the House would stand at ease to allow members of the Senate to enter the Chamber; and so, the House stood at ease at 6:52 p.m.

#### AFTER AT EASE

The Speaker called the House back to order at 7:00 p.m.

#### JOINT SESSION IN THE HOUSE

In accordance with Uniform Rule 51, Speaker Chenault turned the gavel over to President Stevens who called the joint session to order at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of the joint session was to hear the State of the State Address by the Honorable Sean Parnell, Governor of Alaska.

Senator Meyer moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the Senate be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

Representative Austerman moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

President Stevens appointed Representative Olson and Senator Menard to escort the Governor to the joint session.

The Senate Sergeant-at-Arms announced the Governor's entrance into the House Chamber.

Governor Parnell was escorted to the rostrum and welcomed by President Stevens.

Governor Parnell delivered his address, and it is published in Senate and House Joint Journal Supplement No. 1.

Governor Parnell received a standing ovation and was escorted from the Chamber by Representative Olson and Senator Menard.

Senator Meyer moved and asked unanimous consent that the joint session adjourn. There being no objection, President Stevens adjourned the joint session at 7:27 p.m.

The Speaker ordered the House at ease to allow members of the Senate to leave the Chamber.
