Message dated April 19 was read stating the House concurred in the Senate amendment to CS FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 359(FIN) am, thus adopting:

CS FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 359(FIN) am S "An Act relating to conspiracy to commit human trafficking in the first degree or sex trafficking in the first degree; relating to the crime of distribution of indecent material to minors, the crime of online enticement of a minor, the crime of prostitution, and the crime of sex trafficking; relating to forfeiture of property used in prostitution offenses; relating to testimony by video conference; adding Rule 38.3, Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure; and providing for an effective date."
