1 Page 1, line 2, following "**Refuge**":

2 Insert "; **designating the House of Wickersham as the official residence of the**
3 **lieutenant governor and making the House of Wickersham available for other uses; and**
4 **relating to per diem claims by the lieutenant governor that are related to the location of**
5 **the official residence of the lieutenant governor"**

7 Page 3, following line 17:

8 Insert a new bill section to read:

9 "*** Sec. 2.** AS 44.19.020 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

10 (b) The House of Wickersham in Juneau is designated as the official residence
11 of the lieutenant governor. The House of Wickersham shall be

12 (1) used as the living quarters for the lieutenant governor and as a
13 place for the conduct of official and ceremonial duties of the lieutenant governor, and
14 shall be available for use by the Alaska Historical Commission established under
15 AS 41.35.300;

16 (2) managed to maintain its historical integrity; and

17 (3) shall be available for public tours and events.

18 (c) If the House of Wickersham is not used as the primary residence of the
19 lieutenant governor and the lieutenant governor is in Juneau for state business, the
20 lieutenant governor may claim per diem, but shall reimburse the state for the cost of
21 accommodations."
