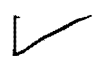

11 **WHEREAS** a vast majority of Americans recognize that the influence of large  
12 contributions by corporations, wealthy individuals, and organizations harms the ability of  
13 average citizens to have a voice in their own government; and

14 **WHEREAS** the narrow majority five to four decision of the United States Supreme  
15 Court in Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission, 558 U.S. 310 (2010), allows  
16 corporations and unions to make unlimited independent expenditures supporting or opposing  
17 a candidate for public office; and

18 **WHEREAS** unlimited independent expenditures from corporations and unions were  
19 prohibited until the ruling of the United States Supreme Court in Citizens United v. Federal  
20 Election Commission; and

21 **WHEREAS** much of the hundreds of millions of dollars being spent by corporations  
22 and unions since the ruling of the United States Supreme Court in Citizens United v. Federal  
23 Election Commission is used for negative ads, which often misinform voters rather than lead

1 to a productive discussion of the states' and nation's most important issues; and

2       **WHEREAS**, unless the United States Supreme Court reverses its ruling, the only way  
3 to reverse the harmful effects of the Citizens United ruling is to amend the Constitution of the  
4 United States; and

5       **WHEREAS**, while not addressed by the United States Supreme Court's ruling in  
6 Citizens United, unlimited independent expenditures made by individuals also distort the  
7 political process and ability of all American citizens to have an equal voice in government;"
