FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act establishing July 21 each year as Jay Hammond Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.130. Jay Hammond Day.** Jay Hammond Day is established on
5 July 21 of each year to honor Governor Jay Hammond. Jay Hammond Day may be
6 observed by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
