FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act repealing the authority of the commissioner of fish and game to adopt**
2 **regulations permitting residents of Yukon, Canada, to receive fishing licenses and**
3 **anadromous king salmon tags for the same fees charged to Alaska residents."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**
