A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**1 **"An Act relating to experimental vehicles."**2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**3 *** Section 1.** AS 28.10.181 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (hh) Experimental vehicles. A vehicle manufacturer or distributor may apply
 5 for experimental vehicle plates. A plate issued under this subsection may be used only
 6 on an experimental vehicle present in the state. The vehicle manufacturer shall certify
 7 to the department that, at the conclusion of the testing, the experimental vehicle was
 8 destroyed or removed from the state. Experimental vehicle plates issued under this
 9 subsection are valid for a 12-month period and may be renewed for additional 12-
 10 month periods, up to a maximum of 36 months, until the testing is complete.
 11 Notwithstanding AS 28.10.201, an experimental vehicle may not be titled under this
 12 chapter. In this subsection, "experimental vehicle" means a vehicle in the
 13 developmental stage that has not yet reached production in the United States.

14 *** Sec. 2.** AS 28.10.201(a) is amended to read:

15 (a) Except as otherwise provided in (b) of this section or in AS 28.10.131,

1 [AND] 28.10.152, **and 28.10.181(hh)**, every owner of a vehicle subject to registration
2 in this state shall apply for a certificate of title under this chapter.
