BILL NO. CSHB 32(L&C)

Analysis

HB 32 amends AS 43.70 to provide for the issuance of one business license for multiple trades, services, professions, or activities and for the issuance of a new business license to make a change on the license.

Service costs of 8.5 include modifying the Business License database and provide for legal costs associated with regulation change. The database will be modified to allow for filtering and search of the primary and secondary NAICS (North American Industry Classification System) codes on the database and printing the primary and secondary trade, service, profession, or activity on the business license certificate.
