Analysis

The Free Conference Committee Substitute for House Bill 71 will reinstate the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission (CFEC) vessel-based limited entry system for the Bering Sea hair crab fishery and puts into place a reporting requirement for CFEC to report on their system every two years . The vessel-based limited entry program had sunsetted on Dec. 30, 2013. The Bering Sea hair crab fishery is currently closed until such a time when the population reaches a harvestable level again.

Passage of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on the Division of Commercial Fisheries.
