**Analysis**

This legislation extends the reporting date for and the termination date of the Comprehensive Autism Early Diagnosis and Treatment Task Force to January 15, 2015.

The task force was established during the 27th Legislature under SB 74 and was charged with submitting a report to the legislature and governor no later than January 15, 2013. The task force was set to terminate January 15, 2013, unless extended.

The Division of Insurance does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this legislation.
