BILL NO. CSHB 190(EDC)

Analysis

The Committee Substitute will have no fiscal impact to the department. CSHB 190 (EDC) adds language to clarify that districts are not immediately required to develop an assessment tool for every course offered in the district.

Section 1

Requires school districts to provide the opportunity for students enrolled in secondary school to challenge courses provided by the district, and earn full credit for the course, if mastery is demonstrated. School districts must establish assessment tool for the student to demonstrate secondary school course mastery.

Section 2

Applies the requirements outlined in section 1 to the State Boarding Schools.
