Analysis

HB206 would amend AS 21.03.021(e) to exclude contracts to provide service on a motor vehicle subject to registration under AS 28.10.011.

HB206 also amends AS 45.25.620(a) to read:

(a) A motor vehicle service contract must be in writing and contain all disclosures required by AS 21.59.

The Division of Insurance does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this legislation.
