Sec. 2 14.30.278 (c) (1) The committee substitute aligns to information currently collected under the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Annual performance report (APR). This information is federally defined under **Indicator 14:** Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were:

- A. Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school.
- B. Enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school.
- C. Enrolled in higher education or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school.
