FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS #1

**STATE OF ALASKA
2014 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

BILL NO. CSHB 235(STA)

Analysis

This bill amends two portions of AS 15.13 and one section of AS 39.50. In each case the bill would require that proceedings and hearings of the commission relating to a complaint filed under AS 15.13 or AS 39.50 be kept confidential and that the complaint and all documents relating to the investigation be kept confidential until the commission determines that a violation has occurred. Commission hearings regarding complaints would be closed to the public until a violation is determined to have occurred. Until a violation is determined to have occurred the complaint and all documents would not be considered as public documents for the purposes of AS 40.25.110 – .140. The subject of a complaint may waive the confidentiality provision.

As written this bill has no fiscal impact on the Alaska Public Offices Commission. No new positions, equipment, space, or funding is required for the Alaska Public Offices Commission to execute its duties if this bill is passed as written. This bill has no impact on the agency's performance measures.
