BILL NO. CSSSHB 238(CRA)

Analysis

The bill changes the language in AS 29.71.040 increasing the procurement preference percentage from 7% to 12% for agricultural products harvested or processed in the state when purchased by municipalities or school districts that receive state funds.

The proposed change to the language in AS 36.15.050 increases the procurement preference percentage from 7% to 12% for fisheries products harvested or processed in the state when purchased by the state or school districts that receive state funds.

The Department of Administration, Division of General Services does not anticipate any fiscal impact from the proposed legislation and therefore submits a zero fiscal note.
