FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS #1

BILL NO. HB 357

Analysis

HB357 adds accompanying spouses to those able to purchase alcoholic beverages in a licensed club premises under AS 04.11.110(d), and amends AS 04.11.110(g) to allow access to patriotic organizations licensed as clubs by persons under 21 years of age as a guest of a member of the club or the spouse accompanying a guest, if the guest possesses a valid active duty military or armed forces identification card.

HB357 under AS 04.16.049(a) adds subsection (4) that allows persons under 21 and permitted under AS 04.11.110g() to enter and remain on club licensed premises.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
