**FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS #3**

**STATE OF ALASKA

**BILL NO. CSSSSB 100(EDC)**

**Analysis**

Section 1 establishes a "personalized learning opportunity grant program" for the purpose of providing technological equipment, technical support, and training in the use of one electronic device for each student. The program would be administered by the Association of Alaska School Boards (AASB) through a direct grant from EED using funds appropriated from the state general fund, and will require an annual report to the department as a condition for further funding. The bill does not indicate an amount of funding for this component of the program.

This section also establishes an "innovative approach to learning grant program" to encourage innovative approaches to learning by school districts. The program would be administered by EED and would be available to districts in a prioritized order of residential schools, correspondence programs, charter schools, vocational education programs, pre-elementary projects, and other public programs. EED would be required to submit an annual report to the legislature documenting projects funded, results obtained, and methods for replication. The bill does not indicate an amount of funding for this component of the program.

Section 2 of this legislation amends AS 14.03 by adding a new Article 3. Correspondence Study Programs. This section has no fiscal impact to the department. It will require changes to current regulations related to correspondence study programs (4 AAC 33.405 - 490).
