Representative Costello addressed the fiscal notes including one indeterminate note from the Department of Health and Social Services and one fiscal impact note from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development (DCCED). The DCCED note showed a fiscal impact of \$46,600 in FY 15 and an annual impact of \$1,700 in FY 16 through FY 20.
