8 **** Section 1.** AS 19.10.300(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) Evidence of security required under (a) or (h) of this section shall be filed
10 with the department and must be

11 (1) a policy or certificate of insurance issued by an insurer acceptable
12 to the department;

13 (2) a bond of a surety company licensed to write surety bonds in the
14 state;

15 (3) evidence accepted by the department, showing ability to self-insure;

16 or

17 (4) other security approved by the department.

18 *** Sec. 2.** AS 19.10.300(e) is amended to read:

19 (e) When operating a commercial motor vehicle or motor vehicle for which
20 security is required under (a) or (h) of this section, a person shall carry proof of
21 insurance and, if involved in an accident with another person, shall display the proof
22 of insurance to the other person. In this subsection, "proof of insurance" means a

23 (1) certificate of self-insurance acceptable to the department;

1 (2) card issued by an insurer described in (b)(1) of this section that
2 indicates that insurance has been procured as required by this section, that contains a
3 local or toll-free telephone number for filing or receiving claim information, and that
4 indicates the name and address of the insurer; or

5 (3) copy of the surety bond described in (b)(2) of this section.

6 * **Sec. 3.** AS 19.10.300 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 (h) A person who transports refined fuels for commercial purposes in a
8 commercial motor vehicle shall maintain security in the amount of \$5,000,000 to
9 respond to damages resulting from a spill of the refined fuel being transported."
