2 Insert "; and relating to child safety devices in motor vehicles"

5 Insert a new bill section to read:

6 "\* Sec. 2. AS 28.05.095(b) is amended to read:

7 (b) Except as provided in (c) of this section, a driver may not transport a child  
8 under the age of 16 in a motor vehicle unless the driver has provided the required  
9 safety device and properly secured each child as described in this subsection. A child

10 (1) less than one year of age or a child one year of age or older who  
11 weighs less than 20 pounds shall be properly secured in a rear-facing child safety seat  
12 that meets or exceeds standards of the United States Department of Transportation and  
13 is used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions;

14 (2) one or more years of age but less than four [FIVE] years of age  
15 who weighs 20 pounds or more shall be properly secured in a child restraint device  
16 that meets or exceeds the standards of the United States Department of Transportation  
17 and is used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions;

18 (3) over four years of age but less than eight years of age who is less  
19 than 57 inches in height and weighs 20 or more pounds but less than 65 pounds shall  
20 be properly secured in a booster seat that is secured by a seat belt system or by another  
21 child passenger restraint system that meets or exceeds the standards of the United  
22 States Department of Transportation and is used in accordance with the manufacturer's  
23 instructions;

1                   (4) over four years of age who exceeds the height or weight  
2 requirements in (3) of this subsection shall be properly secured in a seat belt;

3                   (5) eight years of age but less than 16 years of age who does not  
4 exceed the height and weight requirements in (3) of this subsection shall be properly  
5 secured in a child safety device approved for a child of that size by the United States  
6 Department of Transportation or in a safety belt, whichever is appropriate for the  
7 particular child as determined solely by the driver."
