4 (b) At the first appearance before a judicial officer, a person may be detained
5 up to 48 hours for the prosecuting authority to demonstrate that release of the person
6 under AS 12.30.011 would not reasonably ensure the appearance of the person or will
7 pose a danger to the victim, other persons, or the community, if the person has been
8 charged with the following crimes:

9 (1) an unclassified, class A, or class B felony;

10 (2) a class C felony under AS 11.41.220, 11.41.260, 11.41.425,
11 AS 11.46.310, 11.46.360, AS 11.51.100(d)(2) or (f), 11.51.200, AS 11.56.320,
12 11.56.335, 11.56.540, 11.56.590, 11.56.610, 11.56.770, 11.56.835,
13 AS 11.61.123(f)(1), 11.61.127, 11.61.128(d), 11.61.140(h), 11.61.200,
14 11.61.240(b)(3), or 11.61.250; or

15 (3) a class C felony, other than a class C felony listed in (2) of this
16 subsection, and the person has been assessed as moderate to high risk under
17 AS 12.30.011(c)(2)."
