2 Insert "relating to special request specialty organization plates;"

8 Page 2, following line 7:
9 Insert a new subsection to read:
10 "(jj) Special request specialty organization plates. The department shall adopt
11 regulations to allow for the issuance of special request specialty organization
12 registration plates sponsored by an organization that is based in this state and is tax
13 exempt under 26 U.S.C. 501(c), is an Alaska chapter of a national organization that is
14 tax exempt under 26 U.S.C. 501(c), is a department of the state, or is a municipality of
15 the state. The department shall determine a common design and color for the plates
16 and provide for the placement of the artwork of the organization and a short piece of
17 descriptive text on the plate. The department may disapprove the issuance of
18 registration plates under this subsection when the requested plates duplicate an
19 existing registration. The department may not accept an application from an
20 organization or approve or issue a new specialty registration plate sponsored by an
21 organization under this subsection on or after June 1, 2020. The department may
22 continue to register and renew specialty registration plates sponsored by an
23 organization and approved by the department before June 1, 2020. The legislature may

1 disapprove a plate issued under this subsection by law. If the legislature disapproves a
2 plate issued under this subsection, the department may not issue more plates with the
3 disapproved design. The regulations

4 (1) must provide that the entity requesting the issuance of the plates

5 (A) submit an application on a form provided by the
6 department;

7 (B) pay an application fee set by the department for issuance of
8 the new registration plates;

9 (C) submit registration fees for at least 10 motor vehicles
10 before specialty registration plates will be issued;

11 (D) may not be offensive in purpose, nature, activity, or name;

12 (E) may charge a fee for issuance of a specialty registration
13 plate in addition to any registration fees set by statute or regulation;

14 (2) must provide for a minimum number of registrations and renewals
15 of the specialty plate and for cancellation of specialty plates that do not meet that
16 minimum; the regulations must provide that before a specialty plate may be cancelled
17 the entity sponsoring the plate be given notice at least six months before the proposed
18 cancellation;

19 (3) must establish procedures for owners of vehicles to purchase
20 specialty registration plates under this subsection."

28 "(26) special request specialty organization plates under
29 AS 28.10.181(jj)..... \$30

31 fee required by this paragraph shall be collected only on the first issuance of and the

1 replacement of the plates; in addition, an entity sponsoring a special request specialty
2 organization plate may charge a fee on first issuance and renewal of the plates."
