1 Page 1, line 1, following "Act":

2 Insert "relating to registration plates;"

4 Page 1, following line 4:

5 Insert a new bill section to read:

6 **\*\* Section. 1.** AS 28.10.161(b) is amended to read:

7 (b) Every passenger vehicle registration plate, except as specifically provided  
8 in AS 28.10.181, shall have displayed on [UPON] it

9 (1) either

10 (A) the Alaska flag design, consisting of the Alaska flag, the  
11 traditional colors of yellow-gold and blue, and the slogan "The Last Frontier";  
12 or

13 (B) the bear design, consisting of a standing grizzly bear in the  
14 center of the plate; the bear design shall be modeled after the 1976 bicentennial  
15 plate without the bicentennial symbol;

16 (2) the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is  
17 issued; **the registration number may not display more than six letters or numbers,**  
18 **except that a special registration plate issued under AS 28.10.181 may not contain**  
19 **more than seven letters or numbers;**

20 (3) the name of this state, which may be abbreviated; and

21 (4) the registration year number or expiration date for which time it is  
22 validated; the registration year number or expiration date may be part of the license  
23 plate or contained on a suitable sticker or tab device issued by the department;

1           however, only one sticker or tab device may be issued for each pair of plates, and the  
2           sticker or tab device must be affixed to the rear plate."
