13 "(jj) Honorary foreign consul plates. Upon application by the owner of a motor
14 vehicle, the department may issue registration plates for current honorary consuls of
15 foreign countries. In the application and at each renewal period for the plates, the
16 owner shall supply written proof that the owner is currently appointed as an honorary
17 consul by the foreign country and a copy of the owner's current Consular
18 Identification Card issued by the United States Department of State. The owner may
19 display the honorary foreign consul plates on the vehicle only while the person retains
20 the status of honorary consul of the foreign country and holds a current Consular
21 Identification Card. Honorary foreign consul plates do not confer any diplomatic or
22 other immunity or any other special privileges.

23 (kk) Special request gold rush plates. Upon application by the owner of a

1 motor vehicle, the department may issue registration plates commemorating the gold
2 rush, modeled after the gold rush centennial plate, but without the word "centennial."
3 The department may disapprove the issuance of registration plates under this
4 subsection when the requested plates are a duplication of an existing registration.

5 (II) Special request plates commemorating the Alaska Purchase
6 sesquicentennial. Upon application by the owner of a motor vehicle, the department
7 may issue registration plates commemorating the sesquicentennial of the Alaska
8 Purchase. In determining the design and color of the registration plate, the
9 commissioner shall consult with the Alaska Historical Commission. The department
10 may disapprove the issuance of registration plates under this subsection when the
11 requested plates are a duplication of an existing registration.
