**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to credits toward a sentence of imprisonment and to good time  
2 deductions."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 12.55.027(d) is amended to read:

5 (d) A court shall [MAY NOT] grant credit against a sentence of imprisonment  
6 for time spent in a private residence or under electronic monitoring.

7 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 33.20.010(c) is amended to read:

8 (c) A prisoner shall [MAY NOT] be awarded a good time deduction under (a)  
9 of this section for any period spent in a treatment program, in a private residence, or  
10 while under electronic monitoring.

11 \* **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to  
12 read:

13 APPLICABILITY. AS 12.55.027(d), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, and  
14 AS 33.20.010(c), as amended by sec. 2 of this Act, apply to a sentence imposed on or after the

1 effective date of this Act for an offense committed before, on, or after the effective date of  
2 this Act.
