**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act establishing August 10 of each year as Alaska Wild Salmon Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.121. Alaska Wild Salmon Day.** Alaska Wild Salmon Day is  
5 established on August 10 of each year to celebrate the enormous bounty that wild  
6 king, sockeye, coho, chum, and pink salmon bring to the state every year. Alaska Wild  
7 Salmon Day may be observed by educational and celebratory events, projects, and  
8 activities.
