**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act establishing Indigenous Peoples Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.150. Indigenous Peoples Day.** Indigenous Peoples Day is  
5 established on the 18th day of October of each year, also known as Alaska Day.  
6 Indigenous Peoples Day may be observed by suitable observances and exercises by  
7 civic groups and the public.
