FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to school districts; and relating to layoff plans for tenured teachers."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 14.20.177(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A school district may implement a layoff plan under this section if it is
5 necessary for the district to reduce the number of tenured teachers [BECAUSE

6 (1) SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IN THE DISTRICT HAS
7 DECREASED; OR

8 (2) THE BASIC NEED OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT
9 DETERMINED UNDER AS 14.17.410(b)(1) DECREASES BY THREE PERCENT
10 OR MORE FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR].

11 *** Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 **APPLICABILITY.** AS 14.20.177(a), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to a
14 contract or collective bargaining agreement entered into on or after the effective date of this
15 Act.
