**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to standards for licensure or certification established by the**  
2 **Department of Health and Social Services."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 47.05.310(g) is amended to read:

5 (g) The department shall adopt regulations listing those criminal offenses that  
6 are inconsistent with the standards for licensure or certification by the department.  
7 **The regulations may not provide that the offense of assault in the fourth degree**  
8 **under AS 11.41.230, or an offense with similar elements in this or another**  
9 **jurisdiction, is inconsistent with the standards for licensure or certification for**  
10 **more than one year from the date of a person's unconditional discharge from a**  
11 **conviction unless the offense is a crime involving domestic violence. In this**  
12 **subsection,**

13 **(1) "crime involving domestic violence" has the meaning given in**  
14 **AS 18.66.990; and**

1 (2) "unconditional discharge" has the meaning given in

2 AS 12.55.185.
