**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to the use of state assets to implement the REAL ID Act."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **\* Section 1.** AS 44.99.040(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A state or municipal agency may not use or authorize the use of an asset to  
5 implement or aid in the implementation of a requirement of

6 (1) an order of the President of the United States, a federal regulation,  
7 or a law enacted by the United States Congress that is applied to

8 (A) infringe on a person's right, under the Second Amendment  
9 to the Constitution of the United States, to keep and bear arms;

10 (B) deny a person a right to due process, or a protection of due  
11 process, that would otherwise be available to the person under the Constitution  
12 of the State of Alaska or the Constitution of the United States; or

13 (2) P.L. 109-13, Division B (REAL ID Act of 2005), **except that a**  
14 **state or municipal agency may use or authorize the use of an asset to implement**  
15 **or aid in the implementation of a requirement under P.L. 109-13 relating to**

1 **improved security for drivers' licenses and personal identification cards.**
