5 **psychologist, psychological associate, and social worker by audio, video, or data**
6 **communications; relating to the duties of the State Medical Board; relating to**
7 **limitations of actions; establishing the Alaska Medical Assistance False Claim and**
8 **Reporting Act; relating to medical assistance programs administered by the Department**
9 **of Health and Social Services; relating to the controlled substance prescription**
10 **database; relating to the duties of the Board of Pharmacy; relating to the duties of the**
11 **Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development; relating to**
12 **accounting for program receipts; relating to public record status of records related to**

14 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

15 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
16 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding
17 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of Senate Bill No. 74, relating to
18 diagnosis, treatment, and prescription of drugs without a physical examination by a physician;
19 relating to the delivery of services by a licensed professional counselor, marriage and family
20 therapist, psychologist, psychological associate, and social worker by audio, video, or data
21 communications; relating to the duties of the State Medical Board; relating to limitations of
22 actions; establishing the Alaska Medical Assistance False Claim and Reporting Act; relating
23 to medical assistance programs administered by the Department of Health and Social
24 Services; relating to the controlled substance prescription database; relating to the duties of
25 the Board of Pharmacy; relating to the duties of the Department of Commerce, Community,
26 and Economic Development; relating to accounting for program receipts; relating to public
