FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

**Analysis**

This bill further defines and clarifies provisions of Ballot Measure 2 (an Act to tax and regulate the production, sale and use of marijuana) and provides additional processes for implementing AS 17.38 at the municipal level . It also includes amendments to AS 12.62.400 and AS 17.38.200 dealing with national criminal history record checks for employment, licensing, and other noncriminal justice purposes to require the submission of fingerprints and allow the Department of Public Safety to conduct these checks for persons applying for a license to operate a marijuana establishment.

Passage of this bill would have no fiscal impact to the Division of Statewide Services' Criminal Records and Identification Bureau.
