## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2016 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

SB23 amends AS 09.65 by adding a new section to grant immunity from civil damages, except in cases of gross negligence or intentional misconduct, to persons prescribing, providing or administering an opioid overdose drug to a person at risk of experiencing an opioid overdose.

This legislation adds provisions for the Board of Pharmacy to establish standards for the independent dispensing by a pharmacist of an opioid overdose drug under AS 17.20.085, including the completion of an opioid overdose training program approved by the board.

In addition, it defines health care provider under new sections AS 09.65.340 (d)(1) and AS 17.20.085(c)(1).

Regulations will need to be adopted to implement these statutes; however, it is anticipated that these changes will be incorporated into existing regulations projects.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
