FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2016 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

SB141 criminalizes possession of an “electronic smoking product” by a minor and its sale to a minor. This legislation adds the requirement of business license endorsement for e-cigarette retailers and adds electronic smoking products to areas of law pertaining to tobacco business licensing requirements, including civil fines.

Regulations will need to be adopted to implement these statutes; however, it is anticipated that these changes will be incorporated into existing regulations projects.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
