Pursuant to adjournment the House was called to order by Speaker Chenault at 6:58 p.m.

JOINT SESSION IN THE HOUSE

In accordance with Uniform Rule 51, Speaker Chenault turned the gavel over to President Meyer who called the joint session to order at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of the joint session was to hear the State of the Budget Address by the Honorable Bill Walker, Governor of Alaska.

Senator Coghill moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the Senate be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

Representative Millett moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

President Meyer appointed Representative Wilson and Senator Hoffman to escort the Governor to the joint session.

The Senate Sergeant-at-Arms announced the Governor's entrance into the House Chamber.

Governor Walker was escorted to the rostrum and welcomed by President Meyer.

Governor Walker delivered his address, and it is published in House and Senate Joint Journal Supplement No. 2.

Governor Walker received a standing ovation and was escorted from the Chamber by Representative Wilson and Senator Hoffman.

Senator Coghill moved and asked unanimous consent that the joint session adjourn. There being no objection, President Meyer adjourned the joint session at 7:30 p.m.

The Speaker ordered the House at ease to allow members of the Senate to leave the Chamber.
