3 "It is the intent of the legislature that the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities  
4 not use any appropriation to hire further private sector contractors until a study on the overall  
5 delivery of capital projects and optimization of those capital projects, from onset to closeout,  
6 is conducted. To proceed with privatization, the study must show how the state would save  
7 money by contracting out positions to the private sector and how the state's services would be  
8 improved by contracting out positions to the private sector. Without demonstrating a clear  
9 economic benefit to the state, privatization may not proceed."
