4 (a) To obtain a national criminal history record check for determining a
5 person's qualifications for a license, permit, registration, employment, or position, a
6 person shall submit the person's fingerprints to the department with the fee established
7 by AS 12.62.160. The department may submit the fingerprints to the Federal Bureau
8 of Investigation to obtain a national criminal history record check of the person for the
9 purpose of evaluating a person's qualifications for

10 (1) a license or conditional contractor's permit to manufacture, sell,
11 offer for sale, possess for sale or barter, traffic in, or barter an alcoholic beverage
12 under AS 04.11;

13 (2) licensure as a mortgage lender, a mortgage broker, or a mortgage
14 loan originator under AS 06.60;

15 (3) admission to the Alaska Bar Association under AS 08.08;

16 (4) licensure as a collection agency operator under AS 08.24;

17 (5) a certificate of fitness to handle explosives under AS 08.52;

18 (6) licensure as a massage therapist under AS 08.61;

19 (7) licensure to practice nursing or certification as a nurse aide under
20 AS 08.68;

21 (8) certification as a real estate appraiser under AS 08.87;

22 (9) a position involving supervisory or disciplinary power over a minor

8 reinsurance intermediary broker, reinsurance intermediary manager, surplus lines
9 broker, or independent adjuster under AS 21.27;

12 (16) a school bus driver license under AS 28.15.046;

13 (17) licensure as an operator or an instructor for a commercial driver
14 training school under AS 28.17;

7 Insert a new subsection to read:

8 "(b) A transportation network company may not allow an individual to accept
9 trip requests through its digital network and shall disqualify an individual who

10 (1) as shown on the local or national criminal background check, has
11 been convicted within the last seven years of

12 (A) a crime against a person under AS 11.41;

13 (B) an offense under AS 11.46.100 - 11.46.295;

14 (C) vehicle theft under AS 11.46.360 or 11.46.365;

15 (D) driving while license canceled, suspended, revoked, or in
16 violation of a limitation under AS 28.15.291;

17 (E) a crime under AS 28.33.030, AS 28.35.030, or 28.35.032;

18 (F) a violation of AS 28.35.060;

19 (G) failure to stop at the direction of a peace officer under
20 AS 28.35.182;

21 (H) reckless or negligent driving under AS 28.35.400 or
22 28.35.410;

23 (I) a law or ordinance of another jurisdiction having similar
24 elements to an offense listed in (A) - (H); or

25 (J) any offense that is a felony in this or another jurisdiction;

26 (2) is listed on the United States Department of Justice National Sex
27 Offender Public Website;

28 (3) has been ordered to complete an alcohol or controlled substance
29 education, treatment, or rehabilitation program by a court in the last seven years; or

30 (4) has been convicted of or forfeited bail for more than four moving
31 traffic violations in the past three years."
