## Claims

System was “broken” before—I would agree pretrial system was broken before because often DEFENDANTS ASK FOR PRETRIAL DELAY WHICH DROVE TRIALS UP---

THEN LETS FIX THAT BY NO ALLOWING DELAYS—NOT RE WRITIG THE ENTIRE CRIMINA

Fantasy “research” that is data driven without data –Not provided to Judiciary members -typical buroerocrat says I will get it to you—often with NO follow up-requests in committee need to be followed up like a foia=freedom of information request

When asked for research (note that was “pew not peer reviewed and “analyzed” to meet their objectives

SB91 allows 7-9 ways for perpetrator to get to victim faster—get to public sooner

Cost Saving-imaginary---cost shifting but major costs to public—vandalism, break ins, car theft, burglary, shoplifting---Transparency Impact Act requires that all costs of all regs be done that impact private sector, other department and municipalities—I have asked for Regs to SB 91 showing these impacts--- with NO avail
