A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act prohibiting the expenditure of state or municipal assets to create a registry**
2 **based on race or religion."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 44.99.040(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) A state or municipal agency may not use or authorize the use of an asset to
6 implement or aid in the implementation of a requirement of

7 (1) an order of the President of the United States, a federal regulation,
8 or a law enacted by the United States Congress that is applied to

9 (A) infringe on a person's right, under the Second Amendment
10 to the Constitution of the United States, to keep and bear arms;

11 (B) deny a person a right to due process, or a protection of due
12 process, that would otherwise be available to the person under the Constitution
13 of the State of Alaska or the Constitution of the United States; or

14 **(C) create a registry based on race or religion; or**
