A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act establishing June 27 of each year as Post-Traumatic Stress Injury Awareness**
2 **Day."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 44.12.150. Post-Traumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day.** Post-
6 Traumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day is established on June 27 of each year to
7 promote awareness of the people suffering from post-traumatic stress injury and to
8 encourage people to reach out to their fellow citizens to provide support and eliminate
9 the stigma associated with this injury. Post-Traumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day
10 may be observed by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
