**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act prohibiting the expenditure of state or municipal assets to enforce federal  
2 marijuana laws; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 44.99.040(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) A state or municipal agency may not use or authorize the use of an asset to

6 **(1)** implement or aid in the implementation of a requirement of

7 [(1)] an order of the President of the United States, a federal  
8 regulation, or a law enacted by the United States Congress that is applied to

9 (A) infringe on a person's right, under the Second Amendment  
10 to the Constitution of the United States, to keep and bear arms;

11 (B) deny a person a right to due process, or a protection of due  
12 process, that would otherwise be available to the person under the Constitution  
13 of the State of Alaska or the Constitution of the United States; or

14 (2) **enforce or aid in the enforcement of federal criminal laws**

1           involving marijuana that are inconsistent with state law under AS 17.38 and the  
2           right to privacy in art. I, sec. 22, Constitution of the State of Alaska; in this  
3           paragraph, "marijuana" has the meaning given in AS 11.71.900 [REPEALED].

4           \* **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
