**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**  
2 **Legislature, concerning House Bill No. 16, relating to training regarding disabilities for**  
3 **police officers, probation officers, parole officers, correctional officers, and village**  
4 **public safety officers; relating to guidelines for drivers when encountering or being**  
5 **stopped by a peace officer; relating to driver's license examinations; and relating to a**  
6 **voluntary disability designation on a state identification card and a driver's license.**

7 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

8 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of  
9 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding  
10 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 16, relating to  
11 training regarding disabilities for police officers, probation officers, parole officers,  
12 correctional officers, and village public safety officers; relating to guidelines for drivers when  
13 encountering or being stopped by a peace officer; relating to driver's license examinations;  
14 and relating to a voluntary disability designation on a state identification card and a driver's
