**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**  
2 **Legislature, concerning House Bill No. 307, requiring a person who commits certain**  
3 **offenses under the code of military justice to register as a sex offender or child**  
4 **kidnapper; relating to the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act; relating to contracts made**  
5 **by servicemembers; relating to nonjudicial punishment of members of the organized**  
6 **militia; and relating to offenses subject to court-martial proceedings.**

7 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

8 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of  
9 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding  
10 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 307, requiring a  
11 person who commits certain offenses under the code of military justice to register as a sex  
12 offender or child kidnapper; relating to the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act; relating to  
13 contracts made by servicemembers; relating to nonjudicial punishment of members of the  
14 organized militia; and relating to offenses subject to court-martial proceedings.
